Person

The Club

Avonhead has about 100 senior participants, currently 8 junior interclub teams, and about 60 youngster beginners. The club is growing and the committee wishes to actively sustain that.

The club has 2 hard courts, 4 synthetic grass courts, pavilion and a dedicated coaches office all set in the leafy grounds of Crosbie Park Christchurch.

The club, currently, does not have a paid Junior Administrator and relies on volunteer support and the work of the resident coach.
